Patrice Djarejian Shure is a performing and recording artist, songwriter, and pianist. She has been blessed with the opportunity to perform at some of the world's most prestigious concert halls including her **NYC Debut at Carnegie Hall singing 8 sold out concerts** of Leonard Bernstein's music, with the esteemed American Composers Orchestra. Additionally, she was invited to make her **NYC Weill Recital Hall Debut**, as well as her **critically acclaimed London Recording Debut: *Love Lost and Found***, Handel CD/DVD, with the English Chamber Orchestra (patron Prince Charles / video recorded by the royal videographer).

Further demonstrating her musically diverse talent, Patrice was asked to sing in concert for the Broadway Blessing, with the NYC Rockettes dancing, debuting an original orchestral piece with her lyrics titled "I Sing For You." LHM Media recently released her highly anticipated new album, ***You Are My Song***, a collection of **her original inspirational pop and jazz songs and lyrics** recorded in Nashville.

Patrice is excited about her latest song writing and recording project, being invited to work with Pink's Producer and the Nashville Symphony, on her 12 new inspirational pop songs slated for release in 2022.

As a vocal coach, piano teacher, composer, actor, speaker, and choir director including at The Master's School (grades 6-12) in New York, Patrice's students were catapulted into their careers straight from high school as a result of my leadership. Many of them were accepted into early admissions at Juilliard, AMDA, Trinity Repertory Company, U-M School of Music Theatre & Dance, and New England Conservatory of Music.

Patrice Shure's opportunities auditioning, conducting, choreographing, and coaching young singers and actors in Virginia, included bi-annual performances where she arranged and conducted a 200-voice choir (K-6th grade) with soloists for the school and community. Parts of these performances were televised and praised for the creativity and performance of the students under her direction.

Besides teaching hundred's of private lessons, in voice and piano, both in schools and in her own music studios, Patrice equally enjoys teaching Group Music Theory Classes and directing choral groups of all ages and styles.
